1. ORGANIZER:

The organizing committee (hereinafter referred to as “Committee”) of “**MEDCO PONDOK INDAH INTERNATIONAL AMATEUR GOLF CHAMPIONSHIP 2025**” (hereinafter referred to as “The Championship”) is the Pondok Indah Golf Club Tournament Committee (“The Committee”) sanctioned by the Persatuan Golf Indonesia (Indonesia Golf Association).

2. DATES:

15th, 16th & 17th of July 2025.

3. VENUE:

The Championship shall be played at **Pondok Indah Golf Course**
Jl. Metro Pondok Indah, Jakarta 12310.

4. ELIGIBILITY:

- a) The Championship is open to Man and Woman Golfers 13 years old and not more than 30 years old as of July 15th, 2025
- b) Man or Woman participant must hold a WHS Handicap Index, 8.0 or lower for Men and 10.0 or lower for Women valid on March 2025.
- c) In the case a participant cannot provide a handicap index card, then he or she must submit 6 (six) scorecards played between November 2024 and April 2025. The Committee shall process the WHS Index.

5. FORMAT OF PLAY:

- a) The Championship shall be decided by stroke play over 3 rounds of 18 holes, subject to The Committee’s right, in the event of circumstances which make the playing of 54 holes impracticable, to cancel any round or rounds at its discretion.
- b) The Champion shall be the player with the lowest gross aggregate score over three rounds. Men will tee off from *the Black Teeing Ground* and Women from *the Blue Teeing Ground*.

6. SIZE OF FIELD:

- a. The field will be limited to a total of 140 participants. Entries will be accepted from applicants with lower prescribed handicap index.
- b) The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry without assigning any reason for such refusal. Decision of The Committee as to the acceptance or refusal of any entry shall be final.
- c) After 36 holes, the field will be cut to the 78 leading players for each category to meet the final round field of 26 groups. The allotments are as follow:
 - Men’s Division: Top 54 players.
 - Women’s Division: Top 24 players.

Note:

- 1. In case where the number of Women does not meet the maximum allotted total of 24, then the Men cut shall be adjusted accordingly.
- 2. The cut will be announced on the second day of the tournament at 17:00.

7. AWARDS:

Trophies will be awarded to:

- a) CHAMPION TROPHIES will be awarded to the lowest gross aggregate score over the three rounds for Men’s Division and Women’s Division
- b) Trophies will be granted to five (5) Best Scores of Men’s Division
- c) Trophies will be granted to three (3) Best Scores of Women’s Division.

8. OPENING:

The online registration will open on Monday February 10th, 2025.



9. CLOSING DATE:

The closing date is on **Monday June 15th, 2025 at 11:00 PM**. Late entries may be accepted at the sole discretion of The Committee.

10. ENTRY FEE:

Entry fee per participant:

The Entry fee is IDR 4,500,000 for both Indonesian and foreign participant. Payment shall be made after approved entry by The Committee to the following account:

- *There will be no refund of entry fee after the closing date.*
- *Caddy fees for the tournament days already included in the entry fee.*
- *Caddy tip of IDR 400,000 per round shall be borne by the player, prior to play.*

All entries must be received by The Committee on or before closing date on Sunday, June 30th, 2025.

11. WITHDRAWAL AND REFUND POLICY:

Refund will only be given for withdrawals on or before closing date. Withdrawal after closing date will not be entertained and no refund shall be given.

12. PLAYERS DRAWING:

- a) The draw for the practice, first & second rounds of the tournament will be made by The Committee before the start of the Championship. **The Drawing List shall be out 1 day before.**
- b) The draw for the succeeding rounds will be based on the cumulative gross scores of the preceding rounds.

13. PRACTICE ROUND:

- a) Practice round of registered participant before tournament week (8th - 14th of July, 2024), special golf rate applied:

b) Official Practice Round (18 Hole)

Monday Morning, July 14th, 2025 (Morning Tee Time start from 07.00 AM)

- Golf Rate: IDR 900.000 (include Green Fee, Sharing Golf Cart, Caddy Fee, Gov Tax & Insurance)
- Player pays Caddy Tip IDR 400,000 to be paid prior to play.
- Player is allowed to be accompanied by 1 official coach.

- c) The draw for the practice round will be made by The Committee before the start of The Championship.



- d) No Multiple ball play shall be allowed during the practice round.
- e) Cut-off time for the practice round on Monday July 14th, 2025 is 2:00 PM.
- f) *Attending the practice round is optional.*

14. TIME OF STARTING:

- a) Every player shall start at the time and in the order indicated in the draw. No substitution of players and changes in starting times shall be permitted after the draw has been made.
- b) The event will be held with the first tee-time at **6:30 AM**.
- c) **The Committee** reserves the right to fix or alter the starting times.
- d) Driving Range will open 05:30 AM - 07:00 PM, Price Rp 90,000 / 50 Balls.

15. SUBMISSION OF SCORECARD:

- a) Players should check their cards in the returning area (scoring table) and ensure that they are correct and signed. Any doubtful points should be settled with **The Committee** before returning the scorecard.
- b) A player is deemed to have returned his scorecard, and no further amendments may be made once he or she has left the returning area (scoring area).

16. DECISION OF TIES:

- a) In the event of a tie or ties for the first place, the champion shall be decided by hole by hole play-off to take place as soon as practicable. The purpose of the play-off is to decide the Champion only. In the event inclement weather or other reason to make the play-off impractical, The Committee's decision to determine the Champion is final.
- b) All other ties will be decided on the lowest score for the last 18 hole (or the last 9 or 6 or 3 or 1 holes). If tie still arises, the score for the 2nd round and, if necessary, the 1st round will be treated in the same way until a decision is reached.

17. CADDIES:

- a) The use of caddies is mandatory for this Championship and players are only allowed to use the "in house" caddies and no parents or official are allowed to caddy the player.
- b) Players shall walk at all time and are not allowed to use any motorized vehicle during the stipulated round unless allowed by the Rules Officials

18. DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICE:

A player may obtain distance information using a distance-measuring device. If, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance-measuring device to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g., elevation changes, wind speed, etc.), the player is in breach of Rule 4-3.

19. PACE OF PLAY:

Rule 5.6 (Unreasonable Delay; Prompt Pace of Play) will be strictly using the 'Group Pace of Play system'. See separate memorandum to players for the Pace of Play guidelines.

20. DISPUTES OR DOUBT AS TO PROCEDURE:

If there is doubt as to the correct procedures, players are to refer to the Tournament Rules Official. If a Tournament Rules Official is not immediately available, a player (having notified his or her marker) may elect to play two balls in accordance with Rule 20.1c(3) and obtain a ruling at the conclusion of the round, prior to signing and the return of the scorecard.

No spectators (including parents or accompanying officials) are to enter into any discussion on a matter under dispute.

21. TOURNAMENT RULES OFFICIAL/REFEREE:

The Tournament Rules Official/Referee's decision on all matters pertaining to the Rules of Golf is Final and Binding.



22. INSURANCE:

All players must have appropriate golfing insurance.

23. LIST OF CONFORMING GOLF BALLS:

Rule 4.2a stipulates that conforming ball must be played.

24. DRESS CODE:

- a) Players must be properly attired on the golf course. Blue jeans, designer jeans, round neck T-shirt and tank tops are prohibited.
- b) This dress code will be used in conjunction with any additional dress code restrictions of the host club. A player violating this dress code will not be permitted to start the tournament. A violation of this dress code by player during the stipulated round must be rectified without undue delay or the player will not be allowed to continue play.
- c) Soft-spikes shoes are compulsory.

25. CONDUCT OF PLAYERS:

All players should conduct themselves in a disciplined manner, demonstrating courtesy and sportsmanship at all times, irrespective of how competitive they may be. Rule 1.2b.

26. SPECTATORS/ ACCOMPANYING OFFICIALS/PARENTS:

- a) Spectators/accompanying official/parents must remain on the cart path at all times. They must stay off the greens and out of the bunkers at all times. They must stay off the greens and out of the bunkers at all times. They are prohibited from using golf buggies.
- b) They should maintain a reasonable distance from the players to avoid the appearance that they are imparting advice or assisting the player in any way. They may approach a player for a moment to exchange clothing, food or beverage, but should not have prolonged contact.
- c) Those found violating these policies may be asked to leave the course.

27. AMENDMENTS TO TERMS:

The Committee reserves the right to amend these Championship terms.

27.1 Point 4.a) [Eligibility] is amended to:

“The Championship is open to Man and Woman Amateurs not younger than 13 years old and not more than 55 years old as of July 15th, 2025”

28. GOLF BAG STORAGE:

Golf bag storage will be provided at the Club House
